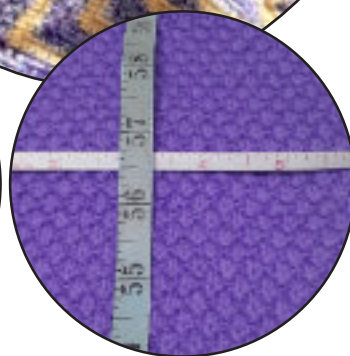

Moss Stitch Adventures

CROCHET

Come and learn how to work the crocheted Moss Stitch, also called linen stitch.

Skills used

- Single crochet
- Charts available
- Work flat and in the round
- Work right or left handed

FINISHED SIZE

The finished size will vary depending on the hook and yarn combination chosen as well as your tension. The finished size doesn't matter as this is just to get a taste of how to work this stitch.

MATERIALSYarn

Any smooth, solid color scrap yarn will work.

Hook

Choose a hook that is an appropriate size for the yarn.

Notions

Stitch marker to mark the right side of your work or the beginning of the round.

Tapestry needle

NOTES

- Changing out the single crochets and using half double crochets, double crochets and even treble crochets will change the drape and look of your finished piece, but might give a stripe height that you want. Give it a try!

ABBREVIATIONS-US crochet terms

beg - beginning

ch(s) - chain(s)

hk - hook

lp(s) - loop(s)

rep - repeat(s) (ing)

rnd(s) - round(s)

sc - single crochet

sk - skip

sl - slip

sp(s) - space(s)

st(s) - stitch(es)

YO - yarn over

WORKED FLAT, 2 ROW REPEAT

Ch an even number of sts.

Row 1: Sc in the 2nd ch from hk, (ch 1, sk the next ch, sc in the next ch) across.

Row 2: Turn, ch 1, sc in the same sc and in the next ch-1 sp, (ch 1, sc in the next ch-1 sp) across to the last sc, sc in the last sc.

Row 3: Turn, ch 1, sc in the same sc, (ch 1, sc in the next ch-1 sp) across to the last 2 sc, ch 1, sk the next sc, sc in the last sc.

Rep Rows 3 and 4 until piece is desired size.

Finish off.

Weave in ends.

Block and make notes.

Moss Stitch, 2 Row Repeat

Right handed

**KEY**

O Chain

X Single Crochet

Left handed

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WORKED FLAT, 1 ROW REPEAT

Ch an even number of sts.

Row 1: Sc in the 3rd ch from hk, (ch 1, sk the next ch, sc in the next ch) across.

Row 2: Turn, ch 1, sc in the same sc and in the next ch-1 sp, (ch 1, sc in the next ch-1 sp) across to the last sc, sc in the last sc.

Row 3: Turn, ch 1, sc in the same sc, 9ch 1, sc in the next ch-1 sp) across to the last 2 sc, ch 1, sk the next sc, sc in the last sc.

Rep Rows 3 and 4 until piece is desired size.

Finish off.

Weave in ends.

Block and make notes.

WORKED IN THE ROUND

Ch an even number of sts, being careful not to twist the chain, join with a sl st to the first ch.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in the same ch, ch 1, (sk the next ch, sc in the next ch, ch 1) around, join with a sl st in the top of first sc.

Rnd 2: Turn, ch 1, sc in the ch-1 sp below, ch 1, (sc in the next ch-1 sp, ch 1) around, join as before.

Rep Rnd 2 until piece is desired size.

Finish off.

Weave in ends.

Block and make notes.

Moss Stitch, 1 Row Repeat

- Chain
- X Single Crochet

Left handed

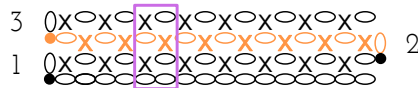
**Moss Stitch, Round**

**KEY**

- Slip Stitch Join
- Chain
- X Single Crochet
